One key requirement is a submitted and accepted MSSA2022 abstract. Grants will be awarded on a first come first served basis for accepted abstracts. Early abstract submission will thus be very important to ensure the best chance for success.

And as always, we won't forget to announce our various competitions and prizes as part of participation at the conference. This includes the always popular MSSA micrograph competition and best presentation awards.
